Exhibition in the Museum Behnhaus Drägerhaus

"Gothmund. Fishing village and artists' place on the Trave"

Gothmund became a fascinating painting place for generations, especially for the Impressionists. The exhibition shows works that were created between the mid-1880s and the late 1920s on the Trave between Gothmund and Travemünde. Paintings, drawings, photographs and sketchbooks give artistic insights into the village, the architecture and topography of the old fishermen's cottages, the artist's residence Israelsdorf and views into the vastness of the landscape.
